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Canopy Health Expands into the South Bay by Adding 3 Hospitals and Close to 1,000 Physicians – Pending Regulatory Approval

A Bay Area healthcare alliance is adding 996 physicians, 3 hospitals, and dozens of ancillary providers. Additions include the Good Samaritan Health System, the physicians of Santa Clara County Individual Practice Association (SCCIPA), Sequoia Hospital, and the physicians of Dignity Health Medical Network — Sequoia.

Emeryville, CA – Thursday, February 8, 2018 — Canopy Health, the innovative physician- and hospital-owned medical alliance, is expanding its network. Today, their executive team announced the addition of the Good Samaritan Health System, which includes Regional Medical Center of San Jose and Good Samaritan Hospital. These two facilities are partnered with the Santa Clara County Individual Practice Association (SCCIPA). Canopy Health has also added Dignity Health Sequoia Hospital and Dignity Health Medical Network — Sequoia, which are part of the Dignity Health network, to their growing alliance.
